

## **Rules Regarding Food in Livestock Areas at the 2007 NJ State Fair/Sussex County Farm and Horse Show**

All 4-H members and their families are required to follow these rules.

There will be no food or drink allowed in:

- Livestock Barns 1-6
- the Livestock Show Arena
- the Milking Parlor
- any structure in the agricultural area which contains livestock poultry, or animals of any kind.

These rules are required by the Fair's insurance. Failure to observe these rules will jeopardize the Fair's ability to operate. We therefore ask for your cooperation.

Any 4-H member or family member who disobeys the above rules will be subject to any or all of the following:

- ejection from the fairgrounds
- loss of premiums
- loss of 4-H Market Animal Sale earnings.

Any open show exhibitor or family member who disobeys the above rules will be subject to any or all of the following:

- ejection from the fairgrounds
- loss of premiums.

**This year the rules will be enforced.** It will be the responsibility of 4-H leaders and open show directors to monitor their groups.

*Judges will be permitted to have bottled water in the livestock show arena during their show. Bottles must be capped when they are not in use.*
