



# Sussex County 4-H Teen Council Scholarship Application

In order to be eligible for a scholarship, the following requirements need to be met:

1. Must be an active 4-H Teen Council member for at least three (3) high school years and must have attended at least 70% of Teen Council functions (including meetings and special events); and completed the required number of Dairy Barn shifts per year.
2. Must submit a completed application and requested documentation to the 4-H office no later than May 1;
3. Must include a copy of your official transcript;
4. Must include a letter of reference from one person not related to the applicant (your 4-H club leader, minister, teacher, etc).

The first part of this application is to be completed by the applicant.

The second part of the application should be completed by a parent; legal guardian; or other person who stands in loco parentis, such as a relative or person with whom the applicant normally resides.

The completed application should be sent to Rutgers Cooperative Extension of Sussex County, 1 Spring Street, Newton, NJ, 07860. The application must be postmarked no later than May 1, regardless of the day of the week May 1 falls on. The application may also be faxed (973) 948-5582 or sent via email, foord@rce.rutgers.edu.
