

Sussex County 4-H Teen Council Scholarship Application

In order to be eligible for a scholarship, the following requirements need to be met:

1. Must be a current and active Sussex County 4-H Teen Council member for at least three (3) high school years, attended at least 70% of Teen Council functions (including meetings and special events); and complete the required number of Dairy Barn Shifts per year.

2. Must submit a completed application and requested documentation to the 4-H office or a Teen Council Leader no later than April 15;

- 3. Must include a copy of your official transcript;
- 4. A letter of reference from a person not related to the applicant (4-H club leader, minister, teacher, etc.).

The first part of this application is to be completed by the applicant.

The second part of the application should be completed by a parent; legal guardian; or other person who stands in loco parentis, such as a relative or person with whom the applicant normally resides.

The completed application should be sent to 4-H Office -Rutgers Cooperative Extension of Sussex County, 1 Spring Street, Newton, NJ, 07860 or via email to patrie@njaes.rutgers.edu. The application must be postmarked no later than April 15, regardless of the day of the week April 15 falls on.
